

Basic and Advanced Training for Operation of IGF ships

Aboa Mare offers a combined Basic-Advanced level course of five-day duration

The participants will gain the minimum standard of competence in basic and advanced training for ships subject to the Code of Safety for Ships using Gases or other Low-flashpoint Fuels (IGF Code). The basic level (STCW A-V/3-1) and advanced level (STCW A-V/3-2) courses are three-day courses including practical fire-fighting exercises. In addition, Aboa Mare offers a combined Basic-Advanced level course of five-day duration.

Basic Training

The course intends to provide a basic training for seafarers responsible for designated safety duties associated with the care, use or in emergency response to the LNG fuel on board ships subject to the IGF Code.

Advanced Training

The course intends to provide an advanced training for masters, officers and all personnel with immediate responsibility for the care and use of fuels and fuel systems on ships subject to the IGF code.
